


Autumn Phillips Group/Jordan

Trip Summary

This trip is a for a private group tour, organized by Autumn Philips.



Detailed Itinerary

Day 1 Monday, 20 October	Amman Arrive in Amman. Transfer to hotel for briefing. Overnight in Amman at Centro Mada Hotel or similar.
Day 2 Tuesday, 21 October	Amman - Ajloun - Jerash - Amman Day trip to explore the ancient cities just north of Amman. Our first stop is Ajloun Castle, a 12th-century fortress built by Saladin's general, Izzeddin Usama, offering panoramic views of the Jordan Valley. We then continue to Jerash, renowned for its well-preserved Greco- Roman architecture. Walk through temples, plazas, theaters, and colonnaded streets dating back over 2,500 years. Overnight in Amman at Centro Mada Hotel or similar.
Day 3 Wednesday, 22 October	Amman Full day in the capital city Amman. Highlights include the ancient Citadel and the impressive Roman Amphitheater. We will then walk trough the lively souks for a taste of local life, before ending the day in West Amman and Rainbow Street. Overnight in Amman at Centro Mada Hotel or similar.
Day 4 Thursday, 23 October	Amman - Mt. Nebo - Madaba - Karak - Petra Today we leave the city and head south towards the red rose city of Petra. En-route we will visit Mount Nebo, where Moses was said to have seen the Promised Land before his death, and Madaba, famous for the 6th- century mosaic map of the Holy Land in St. George's Church. We will also explore Karak's impressive Crusader castle, a massive medieval fortress. As one of the largest castles in the Levant, it offers a fascinating glimpse of the region's storied past. Overnight in Petra at Petra Moon Hotel or similar.
Day 5 Friday, 24 October	Petra - Wadi Rum Morning visiting the breathtaking Nabatean city of Petra - carved into rose-red stone over 2,000 years ago. Begin with a walk through the Siq, a narrow gorge leading to the famous Treasury (Al-Khazneh). Continue exploring the city's tombs, temples, and water channels. Afterwards we head deep into Wadi Rum, known as the Valley of the Moon. Famous for its stunning desert landscape, we spend explore its unique rock formations and scenery. Dinner and overnight in Wadi Rum at Suncity Camp or similar.



Day 6 Saturday, 25 October	Wadi Rum - Aqaba Today we drive to Aqaba, a vibrant coastal city on the Red Sea. Known for its stunning beaches, crystal-clear waters, and rich marine life, Aqaba is a popular destination for water sports enthusiasts, including snorkeling, diving, and windsurfing. Overnight in Aqaba at Luxotel Beach Resort or similar.
Day 7 Sunday, 26 October	 Aqaba - Dead Sea After breakfast we begin our journey back north and drive to the Dead Sea. Being the lowest point on Earth, relax and float in its mineral rich waters while enjoying the serene surroundings. Overnight by the Dead Sea at Dead Sea Spa or similar.
Day 8 Monday, 27 October	Dead Sea - Amman Return to Amman. Free time in the afternoon. Overnight in Amman at Centro Mada Hotel or similar.
Day 9 Tuesday, 28 October	Amman - End Transfer to airport. End of trip.
